

THE LAZY PERSON'S GUIDE TO SENDING BACK THE TAPES

1. If seated, stand up.
2. Walk to where you keep the box that the cassettes were mailed in.
3. If the tapes are not already in the box, put 'em in.
4. Close box.
5. Tear the masking tape (enclosed) into strips long enough to securely bind the box. (NOTE: Be sure to notice that the masking tape (enclosed) is stuck together. Unpeel it, dumbell.)
6. Unpeel the address and return address labels (enclosed) and stick them on the box. It would be wise to better secure the labels with Scotch tape (not enclosed.) (NOTE: To ease the placement of the labels and to avoid confusing clutter, remove the previous labels (if any) and old stamps from the box.)
7. Place the stamps (enclosed) in the upper right corner of the box.
8. With a pen or marker (not enclosed) neatly mark over old writing that is still visible on the box.
9. Be aware that you may slightly change the order in which you perform these steps, as long as you don't do it ass-backwards.
10. Put the box in your mailbox (not enclosed) and send 'em back to me.
11. Don't ever make me have to do this again you tape-stealer you!
