1. "Birds in the Spring" (1933) Silly Symphony.
2. "The China Shop" (1934) Silly Symphony.
3. "The Flying Mouse" (1934) Silly Symphony.
4. "The Cookie Carnival" (1935) Silly Symphony.
5. "Woodland Café" (1937) Silly Symphony.
6. "The Moth and the Flame" (1938) Silly Symphony.
7. "Farmyard Symphony" (1938) Silly Symphony.
8. Transition: Scenes from the works of Walt Disney.
9. "The Grasshopper and the Ants" (1934) Silly Symphony.
10. "Flowers and Trees" (1932) Silly Symphony. Academy Award winner. The first film made in full Technicolor.
11. "Three Little Pigs" (1933) Silly Symphony. Academy Award winner. 'Among animation buffs it's known as the first film to delineate true personality among characters who essentially look the same.' (Leonard Maltin, The Disney Films).
12. "The Old Mill" (1937) Silly Symphony. Academy Award winner. 'The Old Mill was used as a test-run for the new multiplane camera.' (Leonard Maltin, The Disney Films).
13. "Donald's Crime" (1945) Donald Duck; with Huey, Dewey and Louie, and Daisy Duck. Nominated for an Academy Award.
14. "The Tortoise and the Hare" (1935) Silly Symphony. Academy Award winner.
15. "The Wise Little Hen" (1934) Silly Symphony. Donald Duck's screen debut.
16. "The Skeleton Dance" (1929) The first Silly Symphony.
17. "Haunted House" (1929) Mickey Mouse.
18. "The Band Concert" (1935) Mickey Mouse and Donald Duck. The first Mickey Mouse cartoon in color.
19. "Clock Cleaners" (1937) Mickey Mouse, Donald Duck and Goofy.
- \*20. "Santa's Workshop" (1932) Silly Symphony.
21. "Donald's Dream Voice" (1948) Donald Duck; with Daisy Duck.
- \*22. "Thru the Mirror" (1936) Mickey Mouse.
23. "Mickey's Rival" (1936) Mickey Mouse and Minnie Mouse.
24. "Plane Crazy" (1929) Mickey Mouse and Minnie Mouse. Originally a 1928 silent cartoon, this, the first Mickey Mouse, was remade in sound and released after "Steamboat Willie."
25. "Steamboat Willie" (1928) Mickey Mouse; with Minnie Mouse and Pegleg Pete. The first sound cartoon. Although it was the third Mickey Mouse produced, it was the first to be released. The notorious scene in which Mickey "plays" a cow's udder is cut from this version.

- \*26. "Donald's Diary" (1954) Donald Duck and Daisy Duck; with Huey, Dewey and Louie.
27. "Wynken Blynken and Nod" (1938) Silly Symphony.
28. "Music Land" (1935) Silly Symphony.
29. "Building a Building" (1933) Mickey Mouse, Minnie Mouse, and Pegleg Pete. Nominated for an Academy Award.
30. "Ferdinand the Bull" (1938) Academy Award winner.
31. "Goliath II" (1960) Nominated for an Academy Award.
- \*32. "The Pointer" (1939) Mickey Mouse and Pluto. Nominated for an Academy Award.
33. "The Ugly Duckling" (1939) Silly Symphony. Academy Award winner.
34. "Truant Officer Donald" (1941) Donald Duck and Huey, Dewey and Louie. Nominated for an Academy Award.
35. "Squatter's Rights" (1946) Mickey Mouse, Pluto, and Chip 'n' Dale (film debut). Nominated for an Academy Award.
36. "The Brave Little Tailor" (1938) Mickey Mouse; with Minnie Mouse. Nominated for an Academy Award.
